 - c. If your legal parents are unmarried but living together, include both parents
- 3. Your parents' other children, even if they don't live with your parent(s), only if:
 - a. Your parents will provide more than half of their support from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024, OR
 - b. The children would be required to provide parent information when completing the FAFSA.
- 4. Your children if your parent(s) are providing more than half of their financial support from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.
- 5. Other people only if they now live with your parent(s) and receive more than half of their financial support from your parent(s) as of the date your FAFSA was originally filed and will continue to receive that support from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024.
